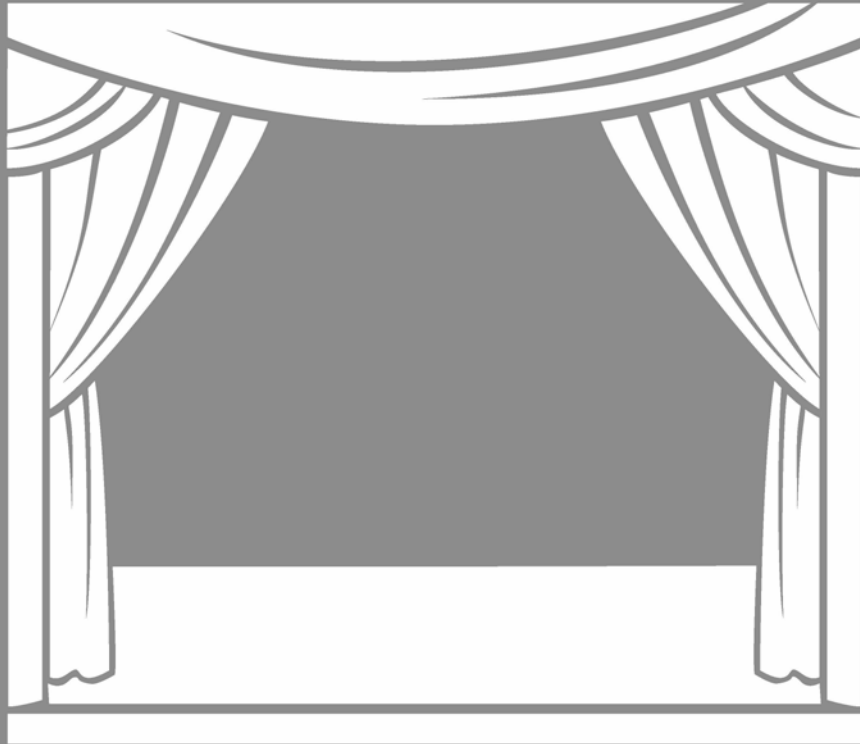

Please apply as soon as possible to insure your enrollment in the next class. Review and processing of your application can take up to eight (8) weeks.

REQUIREMENTS:

Character:

Students will be expected to live in accordance with godly principles as stated in the Student Handbook and the Dress Code and Conduct Information.

Graduation:

Student desiring to attend Charis Bible College Third year Ministry Training Program must have completed First and Second year, and graduated from Charis Bible College of Woodland Park or a Charis extension location.

Tuition Deposit:

Non-refundable \$100 application fee is required with your application.

Upon satisfactory completion of the Third year Ministry Training program in the school of your choice you will receive a Certificate of Completion.

Completed Application:

Visa:

If you are not a U.S. citizen, you must provide a copy of your M1 visa, or permanent residence card (green card) or another type of visa which allows you to legally reside here in the U.S. and attend Charis Bible College of Woodland Park Colorado.

School Descriptions

Business School through mentoring and training will equip you to fulfill your potential in the marketplace and the church. THIRD YEAR CREATIVE ARTS

Course Descriptions

Unlike your previous two years at Charis Bible College, this Third Year program will not be compartmentalized into the standard 10 session courses. It will be shaped and formatted to give you consistent and progressive training throughout your third year. The Creative Arts training takes you on a journey of development and exploration. The class will move together as you learn to hone your creative gifts, both as an ensemble and as an individual.

Our first term will be spent learning the techniques and skills of the disciplines Acting, Movement and Voice. In the second and third term, while your technique training will continue, you will also be expected to put into practice what you are learning through in- house and public performances and showcase work.

This is to give you, the student, the best of both classroom training and practical experience as we endeavor to help you discover fully what gifts God has placed in you and the calling He has designed uniquely for you.

The Acting Course:

This course will run throughout the school year in different guises and give you an understanding of the complexity of creating a character and bringing that character to life on the stage in a believable and truthful way. We will explore the practitioners' methods and endeavor to find a godly system that works for you, the individual. We will explore how to study a script, find the clues which the author has given us as to who our character is and what the play is about. We will learn how to develop character fully, find physicality and emotional truth, break down a play into manageable pieces, discover your objectives and much more. As the course moves on you will get plenty of performance opportunities to put into practice all that you are learning. Both practical and academic, these classes will challenge, excite and inspire your acting abilities.

Voice:

The voice is the actors tool. The actor must be able to be understood, heard and sustain this for the length of the play. This course, that will run throughout the entire year with different aspects of voice training and development, will give you insight into the biology of the voice, exercises and advice for protecting and strengthening your voice, as well as time to develop in a practical and safe environment. These classes will enable you to speak to large numbers of people without a microphone, speak for long periods of time without tiring and help instruct and empower other people who use their voice frequently.

Having as many tools to your belt as possible. Developing a good singing technique will empower you to take on roles that many others cannot handle. Singing is a powerful tool for communicating a message and drawing attention as well as something used a great deal in theatre and film. This course will help you develop your voice, no matter what you think you sound like! Individual classes will give you the confidence and ability to sing in a group and/or solo.

Physical Theater:

Whether you are an actor who moves, or a dancer who can act, you must be able to control your body so it will do whatever is required by the play/part you are involved with.

Understanding how to apply physicality is essential in a truthful portrayal of a character.

Physical Theater helps the actor to explore his/her movement and interaction with cast members whilst igniting the imagination to create scenes, dances and wordless plays. Someone once said, preach the gospel and use words if you have to! Physical Theatre training gives you the opportunity to bring to life stories and messages without the use of words and therefore crossing language and culture barriers for mission, ministry and even marketing.

Basic Stagecraft:

Everything from how to enter the stage, to how to exit! Understanding the basic principles of sight lines, upstage/downstage, finding your light, keeping it real whilst not blocking your audience etc. This is a must for every performer in any circumstance and will empower you with the knowledge to help you and others bring a professionalism to their work for any arena.

Auditions:

Auditioning is one of the most terrifying experiences for many actors and people! What better way to find your feet and your style in a safe and supportive environment? This course will help you develop an audition technique that will give you confidence and awareness of what is being looked for, for each specific job/role. These classes will not only empower you with information but give you the experience of auditioning and the feedback and support to improve each time.

Musical Theatre:

A brief study of the genre followed by practical lessons on how to act through song and still be 100% truthful. We will have great fun finding songs that suit you and working on bringing them to life as actors, not just singers. We will choreograph and stage a musical ensemble number as well as work on solos and/or duets. These skills will be very valuable as the school looks to produce musical theater events for the public.

Spirit-Led Directing:

Acting is a complex and rewarding skill. Directing other actors means understanding what the actor is trying to do whilst getting them to do it the way you want it! This is not easy. In this course we will explore how, as an actor we should work with a director; ways of communicating between director and actor; how, as a director, to get the most from your actors; understanding the overview of a play and working with the technical aspects and people. This empowers the student with the skills to produce a play, or piece of creative art, anywhere, anytime, for anyone. And of course, listening to our ultimate director, the Holy Spirit.

Acting for Camera:

Stage acting and TV/Film acting are very different. This course will teach the actor the difference and provide opportunity to practice working with a camera. We will study some of the great film actors and learn to apply their techniques to our own performances. We hope to work alongside the Media School for this course providing you the chance to work on an actual film project.

Improvisation:

Something that most actors fear! But improv' is beneficial in so many areas of life, not just in theatre. Learning to think and respond quickly and intelligently is key to creating theatre but also to job interviews, seminars and training workshops, meetings and conversations etc. Cultivating an ability to improvise gives the student confidence and assurance in a multitude of scenarios and environments.

Stage Management / Submitting to Authority in Theatre:

Learn the basics of Stage Management and how to call a show, work with backstage crew, organize a production folder and co-ordinate cast and crew. Submitting to Authority in Theater is a great skill to have, enabling you to know when to listen and when to speak, when to say "no" and when to make it happen!

Costume Design and Make-up:

From the page to the stage course on how to design costumes for characters and practical classes on how to physically make costumes of all shapes and sizes! Elizabeth Muren has thousands of hours of experience making costumes and creating designs for many genres of theatre. She will be taking this course and bringing her own flare to this creative process.

Theater Tech:

A course solely designed to giving the student an understanding of the technical aspects of theatre from sound and lighting to set design and props.

Creative Arts Final Project:

Students will combine all they've been taught into a play/musical in which they will rehearse and perform the production in the community whilst being given an understanding of the many different facets of producing a small scale touring show.
