Please apply as soon as possible to insure your enrollment in the next class. Review and processing of your application can take up to eight (8) weeks.

REQUIREMENTS:

Character:

Upon satisfactory completion of the Third-year Ministry Training program in the school of your choice you will receive a Certificate of Completion.

THIRD YEAR MISSIONS TRAINING PROGRAM

MISSIONS SCHOOL COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

These courses are representative of the courses offered and are subject to change.

**Course Title: Workshop Raising Support/Newsletter Writing/Cross Cultural
Communication Instructor: Delron Shirley**

Practical training on raising the level of awareness about your financial needs for the mission experience. Raising support focused on reporting from the mission field. Understanding how to communicate in a foreign environment.

**Course Title: Practical Mission
Principles Instructor: Peggy Shirley**

Understanding your calling and the spiritual equipping that God has provided for you to fulfill it.

**Course Title: Passion for the Harvest
Instructor: Dr. Delron Shirley**

This course explores the biblical mandate for global evangelism, and fulfilling the passion for mission work.

**Course Title: So You Wanna be a Missionary
Instructor: Dr. Delron Shirley**

A hands-on study of practical aspects of not only doing the work of the ministry but also being God's chosen man or woman in the ministry.

**Course Title: The Great Commission/Doable
Instructor: Dr. Delron Shirley**

Scriptural, statistical and factual proof that the gospel can be preached in the whole world in this generation.

**Course Title: Interface
Instructor: Dr. Delron Shirley**

Discovering how spiritual reality interacts with our physical world.

**Course Title: Great Missionary
Heroes Instructor: Dr. Delron Shirley**

Students will research and give oral reports on some of the great missionaries such as like William Carey, Hudson Taylor, Adoniram Judson, and Jim Elliot. They will present their findings during the teaching labs.

**Course Title: Great Commission Focused
Church Instructor: Jerry Williamson**

This course will train the students how to keep the main thing the main thing in church life. No matter what our individual calling is, each of us has the responsibility to do our part in fulfilling the Great Commission – Matthew 28:19-20. Students will be trained in the essential leadership principles involved in keeping a church/ministry “missions focused” rather than inward focused. The end goal of this is building healthy churches and ministries.

**Course Title: Missions Operations-Field
Trips Instructor: Field Trips**

Behind the scenes tours of various mission organizations with a different approach to fulfilling the Great Commission.

**Course Title: Missions
Instructor: Barry Bennett**

Reaching every person on earth with the Good News of redemption is God's greatest desire. We will study the implications of the Great Commission, how it gave rise to the spread of Christianity over the last two thousand years, and how it relates to the responsibility of our generation to reach the nations. Both historical and current missions and missionaries will be reviewed, and the practical aspects of cross-cultural ministry will be explored.

Course Title: Children's Ministry**Instructor: Andy Johnson**

Practical children's ministry instruction, teaching how to utilize all different aspects, puppetry, object lessons, multimedia, dramas and character skits, and mini sermons to help children understand biblical principles.

Course Title: Mission Experience**Instructor: Missionaries in Residence**

The third-year missions track is designed to turn theory into practice by actually giving the students an opportunity to experience first-hand cross-cultural ministry through an extended stay on the mission field. One of the unique features of this program is that in addition to ministry training, the students are required to stretch their faith by actually raising their own funds for the mission six-week experience. The program culminates in a six-week trip in which the students will live with a missionary family and experience twenty-four/seven life on the mission field. The mission experience will be under the direction of veteran missionaries who are well recognized by all the churches and Christian ministries in the country.

Course Title: Debriefing – Mission Experience**Instructor: Delron Shirley**

These class hours cover Praise and Worship, Chapel services, Guest Speakers, seminars, workshops, and conferences that are required attendance for students. They cover various topics of Christian ministry, testimonies, practical application of the Word of God in missions and ministry.

Course Title: Creative Arts for Missions**Instructor: Adam Stone**

A hands-on class in developing drama and visual presentation to make the spoken communication more effective.

Course Title: Media for Missions**Instructor: Tim Swartz**

A hands-on class in video shooting, editing, and production designed to help the student effectively present their mission work to their donor base.

Course Title: Evangelism in the New Testament**Instructor: Steve Bartlett**

This course is a practical ministry course helping students know how to minister supernaturally. We have received the baptism in the Holy Spirit and we have received power to live and minister in the power of the Spirit.

Course Title: Marriage**Instructor: Andrew Wommack**

Marriage is God's idea, and it is between a man and a woman. Andrew will share from the Bible regarding the institution of marriage.

Course Title: Andrew's Choice**Instructor: Andrew Wommack**

Andrew will share from the Word of God, his heart, and ministry experience to equip the students be prepared to step into their call in a powerful way.

Course Title: Principles of Marriage/Spiritual**Formation Instructor: Duane Sheriff**
