School Descriptions

New Covenant Worship

Instructor: Daniel Amstutz

This course is a cornerstone of your training and ministry as a New Covenant worshiper. Building upon the student's first two year of Biblical studies, we will explore how it relates to the areas of worship and worship ministry. We will explore what God's Word says verses traditions of men, designed to mold your perspective on worship as it was meant to be.

Lifestyle of Worship Lab

Instructor: Marcia Alverson

This class is designed to be an hour each week for the class to explore what it means to be Spirit led in a safe environment. Ranging from devotionals, to soaking worship, personal and corporate ministry, prayer, and any creative way the Lord chooses to minister to and through is possible in this class. It is a true Holy Spirit-led creation lab. Instructor will lead and model for the first term, then subsequent terms will be organized and led by the students.

Holy Spirit Led Worship

Instructor: Daniel Amstutz

Through lecture, discussion and expression, this class will explore the concept of leading worship "in Spirit and in Truth". What does it mean to be Spirit led? What does it look like? What is the outcome? Students will be equipped and empowered to lead others in times of Spirit led worship as they grow in this concept in safe environment within our classroom.

Music & Church History

Worship School Courses

Worship Leadership Practicum

Instructor: Various

This class is designed to provide hands-on application for comprehensive music planning in various scenarios including: creating a set list, planning musicians and singers, arranging musical flow and all elements related to worship leading for a church.

Group Piano 1, 2, 3

Instructor: Mark Bovee

With each student equipped with a keyboard on loan from the Worship School, the student will participate in group instruction on piano. The student can expect to learn basic piano skills and knowledge of the piano's function within context of a worship band. Students will be allowed to "check out" their keyboard so they may practice at home.

Group Voice 1, 2, 3

Instructor: Christi Bovee

The student will participate in group vocal lessons as an instructor works with each student both individually and corporately. The class will prepare both individual songs as well as SAT or SATB arrangements, strengthening the voice and developing skill necessary for worship leadership.

Heart of the Artist

Instructor: Daniel Amstutz

Through the book "Heart of the Artist" by Rory Noland, the students will explore in a discussion style format, the various common challenges and issues that artistic people encounter emotionally. Through applying the Word of God, we can arrive at a healthy way to develop as artists that can express the gifts God has put inside us, yet not be controlled by our emotions.

Language of Music 1, 2, 3

Instructor: Mark Bovee

This class is a progressive comprehensive overview study of music theory elements essential for worship leading. Students will learn the basic elements of music including rhythm, melody, and harmony.

Rhythm Basics

Instructor: Mark Bovee

This class is designed to highlight all driving components of rhythm within a band and to show how these elements work together to form a solid foundation for music as it is being created and played.

Creative Expressions 1, 2, 3
