School Descriptions

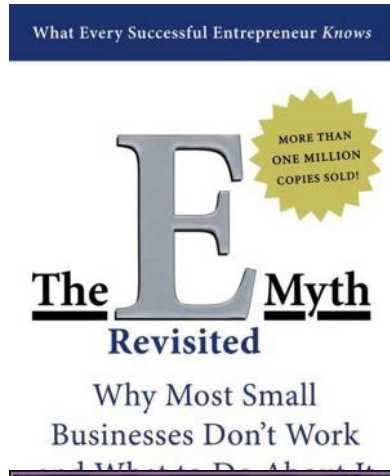

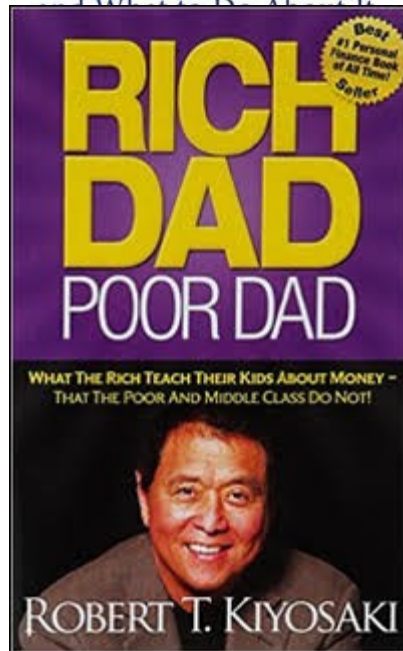

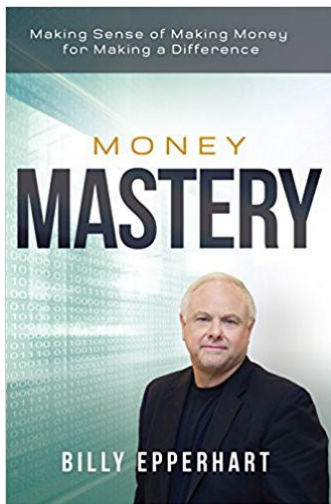
