French-speaking Africa receives revelation of grace and faith!

In May of 2020, with the help of our World Outreach Partners, Andrew Wommack Ministries established an office in France to serve the world’s French-speaking nations, twenty-one of which are African countries.

Shortly after the new French office opened, an office in South Africa joined them in carrying out the French-speaking strategy across the African continent. Currently, more than seventy percent of French speakers who contact Andrew Wommack Ministries are in Africa, and many live in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC).

Anneline Akowuah, director of AWM South Africa, helped

open the French-speaking South African office. “As an office, we have been privileged to serve the French-African community,” Anneline said. “This French department started during the lockdown in 2020, and over seventeen months, we’ve seen exponential growth.”

It began with one staff member, but within three months, they hired two more staff because of the rapid growth. “The French community has been soaking up Andrew’s teaching so much and has been learning so much and has just wanted to learn more of the Gospel message of Jesus Christ,” Anneline said.

Lumière Nsungu is the head of AWM’s African French department in South Africa. “I started in May of 2020 during the lockdown, and for the first month, we received seventeen calls. But that number grew in six weeks to seventy-six calls, and within three months—because of the growth—we needed to hire two more staff members to keep up with all the calls we were receiving,” Lumière said. By September of 2021, the French-African office had received an incredible 1,143 calls.

It’s not only through phone calls that the French-speaking population of Africa now has easier access to the message of grace and faith. When the South African office first opened, it was

too expensive for people in countries like DRC and Côte d'Ivoire to order French-language products.

To make the books and other teaching materials more accessible, World Outreach Partners enabled AWM to open two additional bookstores in Kinshasa and Lubumbashi to minimize the cost and further saturate the French-African population with the Word of God.

Ministers of the DRC walk in a new light.

At a 2020 Ministers Conference AWM hosted in DRC, local pastors were grateful to learn that some ideas they had about the nature of God were not accurate. Isaac Akowuah, AWM Africa Regional Director, attended this ministers conference, and he marveled at what he witnessed.

"We had laughter, we cried, we rejoiced," Isaac said. "More than anything else, we were humbled to see the impact the Gospel of Jesus Christ can have in the hearts of the pastors who came..."

Isaac said the pastors went back to their congregations and repented for not teaching the full Truth of the Gospel. These ministers are walking in new revelation, and many now want to attend Charis to immerse themselves in this new way of thinking and believing.

Charis second-year mission trip

Aaron Nsungu, Lumière's husband, is a Charis student in South Africa. He went on his second-year mission trip to DRC.

"The most important thing to understand about the people of DRC is they've got a zeal for the Gospel," Aaron said. "They go to church from 6 a.m. until 6 p.m., and the church is still full. Everyone is ready to receive the Gospel," he said. "To some of them, it was a surprise to understand that God is a good God—the devil is bad—John 10:10. For some of them, it was their first time hearing it, and they wanted to hear more of this Gospel—the Truth."

Martin Alargent, Director of AWM France, accompanied the group and was deeply impacted by the experiences he had and the people he got to know in DRC.

Martin said, "I met a group of fifteen young people who decided to meet on a weekly basis, who decided to meet to talk about the difference between the Old Covenant and the New Covenant—to talk about the difference between grace and Law... For three years they met... One year ago, one of them discovered Andrew Wommack on TV, and he brought it back to the group."

After this study group began learning the revelation Andrew shares, they called themselves "The Students of Andrew Wommack in DRC."

"They've been transformed by the Word, and they love Andrew Wommack Ministries... They have a huge heart for the ministry, and they're sharing the full Gospel wherever they go, and it was such a blessing to see," Martin said.
