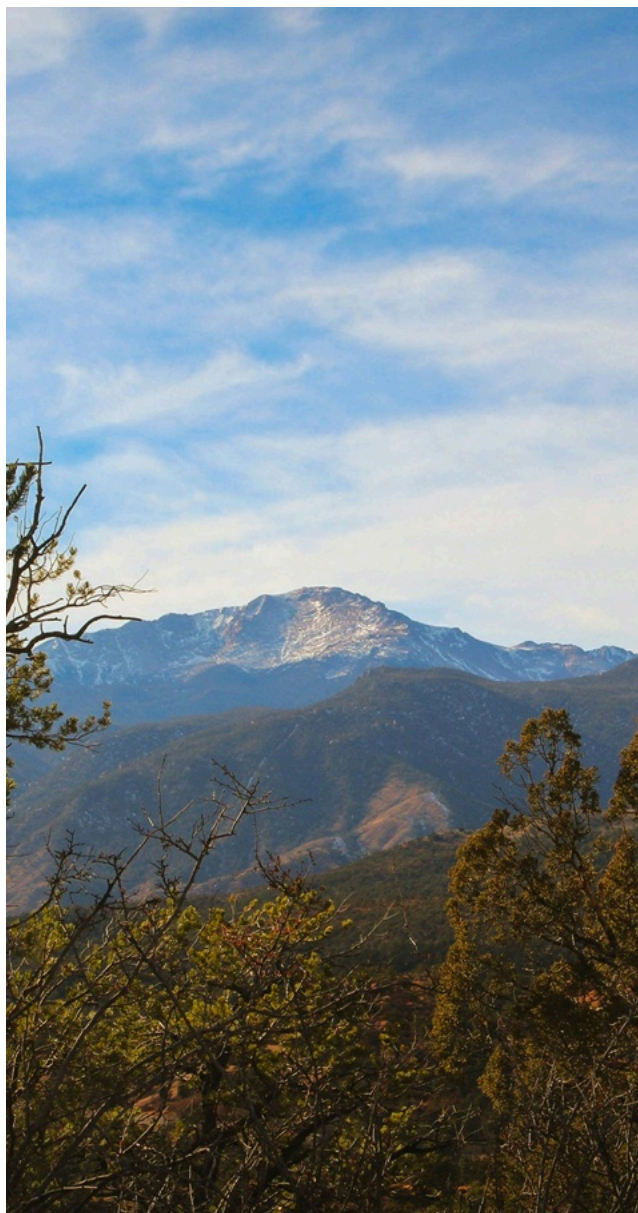

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Does Charis accept VA Benefits?

Yes, Charis accepts VA Benefits. However, there are a few requirements to qualify for VA Benefits.

How do I apply for VA Benefits?

Contact the VA Online at benefits.va.gov or by phone at 1-888-442-4551.


What do I need to provide to the school to start receiving my VA benefits?

We need an updated COE (Certificate of Eligibility) made out to Charis Bible College.

Do I have to be a Day School Student to apply for VA Benefits?

Yes, you have to be a Day School Student. Open enrollment for VA education benefit students is only available for the Fall term.

VEHICLE PREPARATION FOR COLORADO'S WEATHER

Woodland Park, CO, renowned as the "City Above the Clouds" with over 300 days of sunshine annually, still requires awareness of winter weather and mountain driving for those relocating.

Drivetrains

While AWD and 4WD are highly recommended, many individuals with FWD vehicles equipped with high-quality/good tread tires are still able to navigate the area effectively.

Tire Tips

It is preferred to have good snow or all-season tires for the winter season. Low tire pressure warnings may turn on during cold snaps. This can mean less traction and is unsafe on icy or snowy roads. Avoid these by checking your tire pressure regularly. Also, inflate tires to manufacturer's recommended PSI (found in the owner's manual or inside the driver's door frame).

Windshield Tips

There are various types of windshield washer fluid, but winter and summer blends are generally recommended. Be mindful of temperature changes and ensure your washer fluid is always filled. Additionally, having properly functioning wiper blades is essential in this area.

Brake Tips

If you're moving to Colorado, especially living in Teller County, you want to make sure your vehicle's brakes are in top condition for the mountainous terrain and winter conditions.

FUEL TIPS IN WINTER WEATHER

Fuel Tank Tips

A nearly empty tank allows moisture to build up, which can freeze in cold temperatures. Keeping at least half a tank reduces condensation and prevents ice blockages. Heet® Gas Line Antifreeze (or similar products) helps prevent water in the fuel system from freezing. Only use if your vehicle's manufacturer allows it.

Start Your Car Regularly

If you don't drive daily, start your car and let it run for a few minutes to keep fuel moving through the system.

Residents should research, plan, and take necessary precautions for safe travel.

LIVING AT HIGH ALTITUDE

Most individuals adjust well to high-altitude living with proper hydration. However, we've provided a few tips to help reduce the risk of altitude-related effects.

Slowly Acclimate

Woodland Park is located at an elevation of 8,481 feet above sea level. Allow your body time to adjust, as acclimatization varies from person to person. To ease the transition, avoid strenuous activity on your first day.

Check with a Medical Advisor

The effects of some prescribed drugs can be greatly increased at higher altitudes. Be sure to check with your doctor before exerting yourself at higher altitudes.

Sun Exposure in the Mountains

Stronger UV rays at high altitudes increase sunburn risk. Wear sunscreen, sunglasses, and protective clothing.

Tips

- Avoid excessive caffeine and alcohol, which dehydrate you.
- Some recommend to drink at least half your body weight in ounces of water daily (or more if active).
- Keep a reusable water bottle with you and sip throughout the day.
- Eat water-rich foods like fruits and vegetables.

FUN FACTS FOR HIGH ALTITUDE

- Sealed water bottles can bulge, leak, or burst due to pressure fluctuations.
- Lower external pressure causes the nitrogen inside a sealed chip bag to expand, making the bag puff up or even burst.
- Lower air pressure lowers the boiling point of water, causing boiled foods to take longer to cook and baked goods to rise faster and dry out quickly.
- At high altitudes, you may experience dry lips and skin. Using lotion and chapstick can help keep them moisturized.

NAVIGATING WILDFIRES

COLORADO WILDFIRES

What to Know

Colorado has a history of experiencing wildfires. While such events are not a frequent occurrence, it is essential to remain informed and prepared in the event of a wildfire.

Fire Ban

Due to increased risk of wildfires in this area, be aware that outside fires are frequently banned. For more information, including wildfire safety, fire bans, county services, and much more please go to: tellercounty.gov or coloradosprings.gov

Electronic Signage

Watch for electronic signage on the side of roadways with:

- Weather Conditions (e.g. winter weather and fire danger)
- Road Closures
- Traffic Accidents
- Wildfire Evacuations

How to Read a Fire Danger Sign

Fire danger signs in Colorado use a color-coded system to indicate the risk of wildfires. Listed below are the 5 levels of the Fire Risk.

- Low (L, Dark Green): Fire starts are unlikely
- Moderate (M, Light Green or Blue): Some wildfires may be expected
- High (H, Yellow): Wildfires are likely
- Very High (VH, Orange): Fires start easily and may spread quickly
- Extreme (E, Red): Fires will start and spread rapidly

Prescribed Burn

A prescribed burn is a planned fire used to manage land and ecosystems. It is important when you see a "Prescribed Burn Ahead" sign to not report this.

Be Prepared

It is always best to be prepared before needing to take action. You can prepare by keeping exits clear, testing smoke alarms, having emergency contacts, safety kit, and much more.

NAVIGATING WILDLIFE



WILDLIFE IN TELLER COUNTY

Woodland Park, Colorado, located near the foothills of the Rocky Mountains, is home to diverse wildlife. Below are just a few of the animals you may encounter in the area.

Mule Deer

These are the most common wildlife you'll encounter, often seen in various areas, particularly during the early morning and evening.

Elk

Elk typically travel in herds in surrounding areas such as Mueller State Park and Divide.

Black Bears

Black bears are present in the area and usually avoid human contact, but it is still important to maintain a safe distance.

Mountain Lions and Bobcats

Mountain lions and bobcats are less commonly seen in the area and are more likely to inhabit remote regions. Mountain lions are generally larger than bobcats.

Coyotes

Coyotes may be spotted in the area, especially during the early morning and evening, and their howls can often be heard at night.

Foxes

They are known for their distinctive red tails and are often seen in open areas.

WILDLIFE SAFETY TIPS

Feeding wildlife disrupts their natural diet and can make them dependent on humans, leading to risky interactions. Always keep a safe distance from Colorado wildlife, even with good intentions.

Mule Deer & Elk

Drive cautiously, especially at dawn and dusk as they are traveling, to avoid collisions.

Bears & Mountain Lions

Avoid leaving pet food, bird feeders, or trash outdoors. It's also recommended to carry bear spray while hiking and follow the manufacturer's guidelines for proper use.

Coyotes & Foxes

Keep pets supervised, especially at night.

WILDLIFE MYTHS

Deer are harmless and can be safely approached

While deer may seem calm, they can become defensive or aggressive if they feel threatened, especially during mating seasons.

Black bears are always black

Despite their name, black bears aren't always black—they can be brown, cinnamon, blonde, or even bluish-gray. Brown black bears are sometimes mistaken for grizzlies, but grizzlies don't live in Colorado.

What to Pack

Bring essentials like a flashlight, sun protection, a first-aid kit, bear spray, and extra water. These are just the basics—research further to ensure you're fully prepared for your hike.

Outerwear

Wear and pack layers such as a rain jacket, fleece or polyester jacket, extra socks, beanie, and gloves.

Food

Hiking burns many calories, so eat nutritious foods before, during, and after your hike. Bring plenty of snacks and energy bars for yourself and your group.

Know your routes and study the map before hiking. Inform someone of your plans for safety, hike with a partner or group, and review our wildlife awareness tips on pg. 20.
